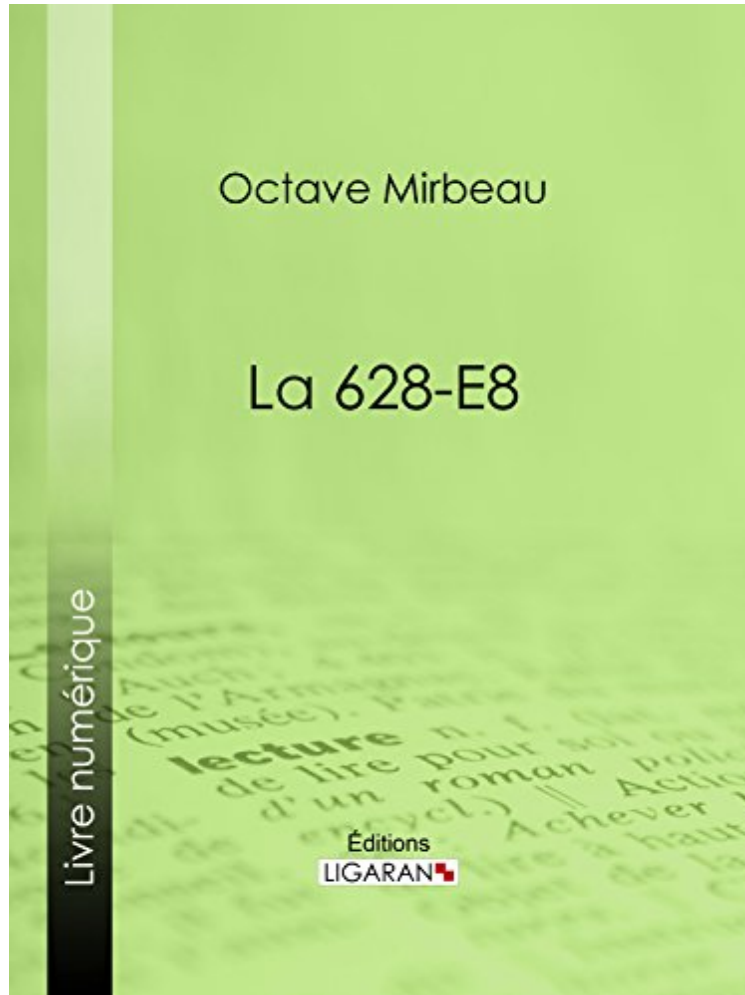

Although the core of his topic focuses on the industrialization of Western Europe towards the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century with the advent of the automobile and its impact, Mirbeau addresses various subjects pertaining to the literary world of the time. Balzac, the French novelist and playwright, figures prominently in this work. The founder of "realism" is depicted as a man of lesser characters, particularly, during his relationship with Madame Ewelina Hanska, the Polish aristocrat. Also, his careful depictions of European cities and their inhabitants in the Netherlands, Germany, Belgium, and France are illuminating and paint a revealing portrait of this period.. He was a firm believer in modernism and the future of technology.
