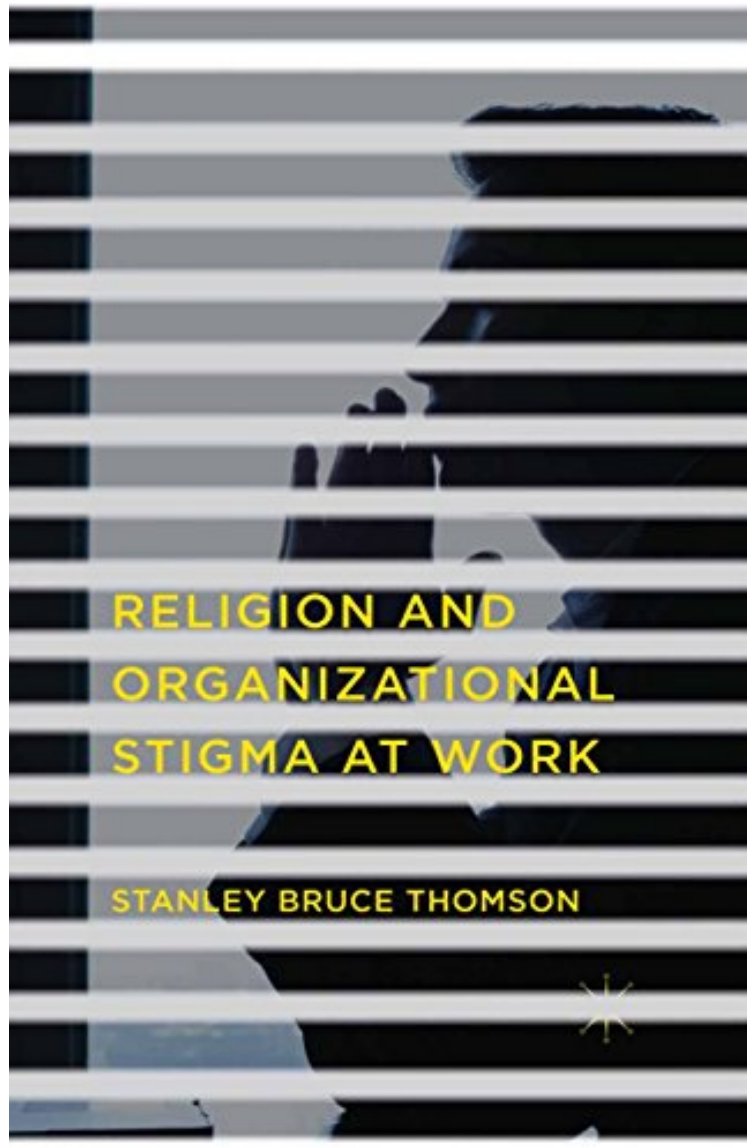

Stanley Plumly's grave, beautiful lyric poems are the real thing, and this is probably his best book--rich with memory, the mellow intensity of landscapes, and the profound sustaining love of friends and family, here and long gone.
